



## Information on your Storks.com Stork Sign (Models 223456 & 223457)

NO Tools Required for Assembly

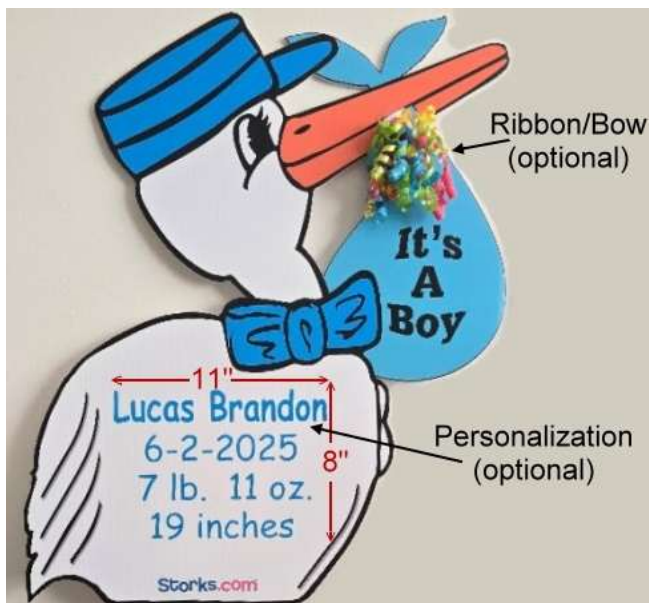

### Unboxing your Stork Sign

We suggest opening your box carefully to avoid damaging the sign. Open from side taped edges only by peeling off the tape. Do Not penetrate the packaging with a razor knife.

Upon opening your package, you will see the Stork's Body and Legs, A taped hinge (waterproof) holding the Stork's Legs to the Body, an Adhesive Hook Mount for Walls, Doors etc., and Three (3) square double-sided Adhesive Pads. Use two or three Adhesive Pads for displaying on Glass, Windows, etc., Four (4) Post Mounts with Eight (8) Cable-ties (zip-straps) for placing on the front of a Step-in Lawn Post, Fence, Railing, etc. (not included). (Figure 3). Contact Storks.com for local purchase of the Step-in Lawn Post.

Note: Do Not remove the Hinge Tape which connects the Legs to the Body.

### Personalization Options

#### Professional:

Storks.com offers the ability to order your Stork fully personalized from us during time of purchase. All the Baby's Birth Information is boldly displayed on the Front of the Stork's Body. We use large, high-quality, highly visible vinyl. We personalize the Stork Signs in-house so this option will not slow up your order or delivery time. (Figure 2)

#### Do It Yourself:

You can personalize the Stork yourself by writing on the front blank surface of the Stork body. The personalizing area of this stork is approximately 11" wide x 8" high (Figure 2).

NOTE: We strongly suggest you personalize your Stork before attaching any mounting hardware.

### Ribbon/Bow (Optional)

Peel and stick the Ribbon/Bow at the crossing of the Beak and Sack Bundle. Location of placement can be at your discretion (Figure 2). Add a piece of clear cellophane tape over the ribbon/bow stick pad for more security if needed. If ribbon hang interferes with the "It's A Boy/Girl" wording, simply cut the excess ribbon strands with scissors.

## Assembling your Stork Sign

1) Place the Stork body lying Face Down on a flat hard surface (preferably a table).

2) Unfold the hinge taped legs. Now you will be viewing the full back of the Stork.

For Lawn Mount: You will see there are four (4) Post Mounts attached to the back of the body of the stork. Two (2) on the Legs and Two (2) on the Body. Lay the front of the Lawn Post on top of these mounts and attach using the included zip-straps. Leave approximately one (1) inch above the bottom Footstep Ledge (Figure 6). NOTE: The back of the lawn post has the bottom foot-step sticking out. Place two (2) Cable Ties (zip-straps) side-by-side through the side slots of the mounts. (Figure 4). Tighten the zip-straps around the Post as tight as possible to prevent the Stork from sliding down the post. Use double stick pads under the cable zip-straps for a non-slip grip by first removing both sides of the protective film to expose the stick on both sides (figure 5). If there are notches, holes, clips, grooves, etc. to put the zip-straps through, you can utilize them instead of the double-stick tape. The Front of the Stake is the Smooth Side.

### Lawn Mounting Tips: (For Lawn Mount Only)

a) Once the Step-in Stake is adhered to the back of the Stork... Carefully push the Stake into the ground by stepping on the bottom footrest while holding by the Stake (do not push from the body of the Stork). Make sure the Stork is straight for best results.

b) If the ground is dry and hard, pour water on the ground and wait a few minutes to soften the soil before pushing the stake into the ground. In the winter use hot water to defrost the frozen ground.

Note: If the Lawn Stake has clips on the back, they will not be used for this application, but they can help for securing the Zip-Straps.

For Non-Lawn Mounting: Do NOT attach lawn stake. See other Mounting Options below. Only attach the Mount(s) you are going to use. Save unused mounts for possible later use.

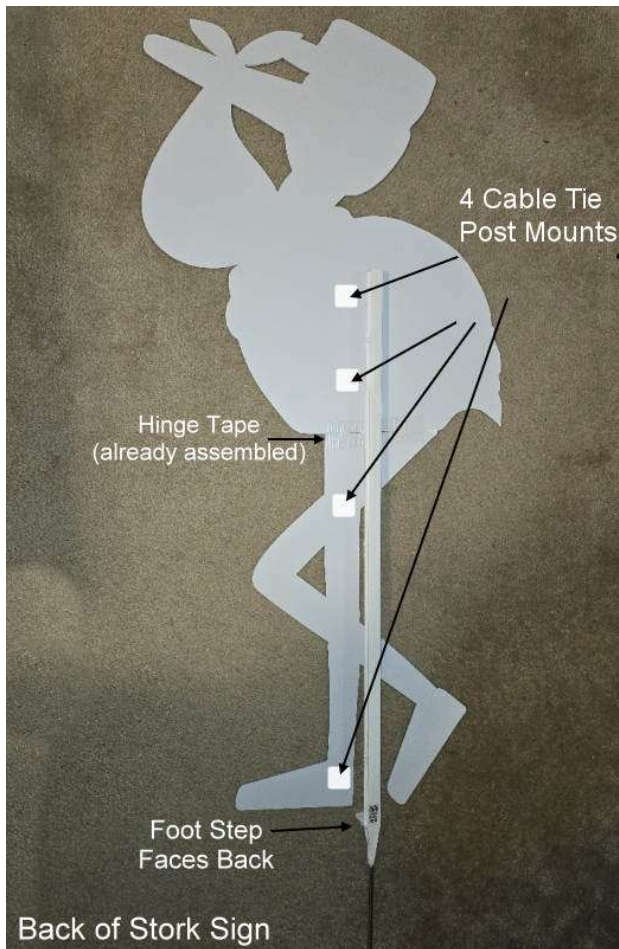

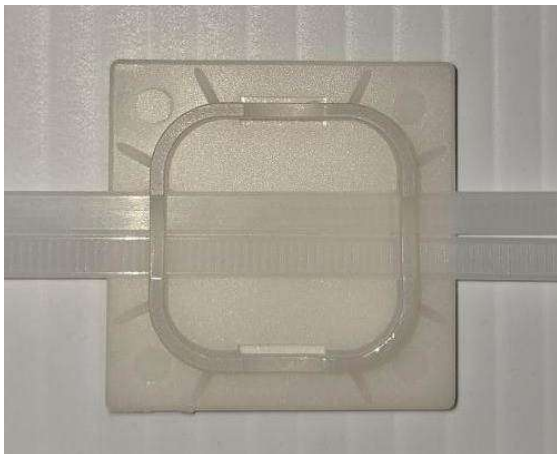

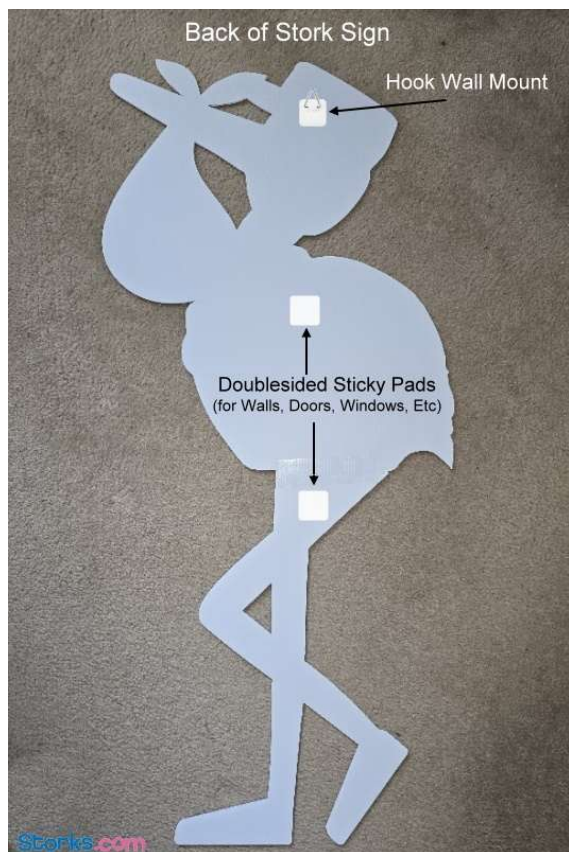

### Wall and/or Door Mount

Place Hook Wall Mount Pad on the back of the Stork's Head as shown (Figure 7) and hang with the loop.

### Outside of Window/Glass Mount

Place the two (2) Adhesive Pads on the Back of Stork and press in place outside of window. (Figure 7)

### Inside of Window/Glass Mount

Place the two (2) White Adhesive Pads on the Front of Stork and press in place inside of window. Be sure to place the White Pads only on White Areas of Stork front in order to blend in. (not shown)

### Get the most out of your Stork

If you are displaying the Stork on a lawn or anywhere outside, we've designed the Stork so you can enjoy the Stork indoors in baby's nursery by hanging it on the wall when you are finished displaying it outside. To do so, simply remove the lawn stake from the body by cutting the cable-ties from the back of the Stork mounts. Then hang on baby's wall inside with the supplied adhesive Wall Hook.
